

Requirements

finished size of quilt: approx 75" x 77" (192cm x 197cm)

finished size of a block: 10" x 10"

Quilt is 6 x 7 blocks = 41 blocks altogether

- 24 Fat Quarters (Full range from Eureka)
- White Fabric: 2.6mts (2⁷/₈ yards)
- Binding Fabric: 55cms (5⁵/₈ yard)
- Backing Fabric: 2.12mt x 2.17mt piece (83" x 85")
or 4.1mt (4½ yards) of 42" wide fabric
- Batting: 2.12mt x 2.17mt piece (83" x 85")

Please read all instructions before starting. All instructions include a ¼" seam allowance. It is recommended that all fabrics be washed and ironed before starting.

Tools

- Rotary cutter, ruler & mat
- 100% Cotton sewing machine thread for piecing & quilting
- Iron & ironing board
- Sewing machine with ¼" patchwork foot & walking foot
- Pencil for marking fabric
- Safety pins for basting

Gold Bullions Quilt

- *NOTE:** From 14 of the fabrics you will make 4 Full Blocks
 From 10 of the fabrics you will make 3 Full Blocks and 2 Half Blocks
 Making a total of 86 Full Blocks and 18 Half Blocks

CUTTING OUT

- From each of the **14 Fat Quarters:**
- Cut 4 - 3½" x 9½" Rectangles
 - Cut 4 - 3⅞" x 3⅞" Squares
- From each of the **10 Fat Quarters:**
- Cut 3 - 3½" x 9½" Rectangles (There will be two half blocks over)
 - Cut 2 - 3½" x 5" Rectangles
 - Cut 4 - 3⅞" x 3⅞" Squares

From the **White Fabric:**

- Cut 10 - 3⅞" strips across the fabric width
- Cross cut to make 96 - 3⅞" x 3⅞" Squares
- Cut 40 - 1½" strips across the fabric width
- Join together to make 20 - 1½" x 75½" strips (Sashing)

From the **Binding Fabric:** Cut eight 2½" strips across the fabric width

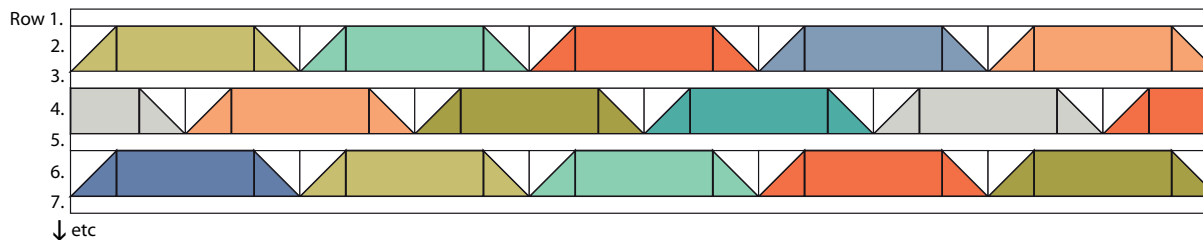
CONSTRUCTION

The "Half Square" method of construction is used to make the Blocks.

- On the wrong side of each of the 96 White 3⅞" x 3⅞" squares of fabric, draw a pencil line diagonally as shown.
- Take one pair of the 3⅞" x 3⅞" squares, and place with right sides together and raw edges matching. Keep the drawn line uppermost. Pin if desired.
- Carefully sew a "scant" ¼" seam either side of the drawn line.
- Cut down the centre of the block along the drawn line.
- Open the two completed squares and press to the dark side.
- Check that the finished block measures 3½" x 3½" and adjust seam allowance as necessary.

SETTING THE BLOCKS

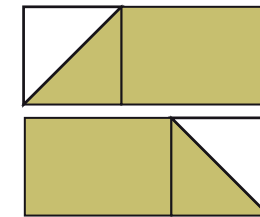
- Layout the blocks into rows.
- There are 10 rows made up of Five Full Blocks and 9 rows made up of Four Full Blocks and Two Half Blocks, with White Sashing between each row.
- Arrange the layout so it is well balanced, and the top and bottom rows are White Sashing.
- Join the blocks into rows, and then sew the rows together with the White Sashing between, until all 19 rows are complete.



Quilt top is now complete.
 Baste and quilt as desired and finally bind your quilt.

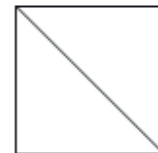


Finished Full Block Size:
