

Requirements

Finished size: 138cm x 184cm (54" x 72")

- 24 Fat Quarters (Full range from Matilda)
- Binding Fabric: 55cms (5/8 yard)
- Backing Fabric: 1.6mt x 2.05mt piece (63" x 81")
or 3.2mts (3½ yards) of 42" wide fabric
- Batting: 1.6mt x 2.05mt piece (63" x 81")

Please read all the instructions before starting.

All instructions include ¼" seam allowance.

It is recommended that all fabric be washed and ironed before starting.

Tools

- Rotary cutter, ruler & mat
- Thread for piecing & quilting
- Iron & ironing board
- Sewing machine with 1/4" patchwork foot & walking foot

SIZE OF QUILT: Finished Quilt Size: 138cms x 184cms (54" x 72")

CUTTING OUT

From each of the 24 Fat Quarters:

- Cut 24 - 2" x 3½" Rectangles
- Cut 16 - 2" Squares
- Cut 2 - 3½" Squares

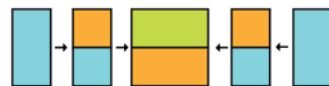
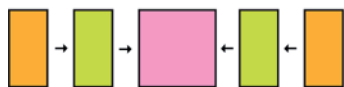
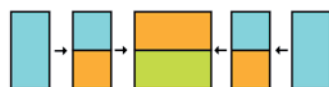
From the Binding fabric: Cut eight 2½" strips across the fabric width

CONSTRUCTION

Make 48 Blocks.

Each block uses 4 fabrics.

Please refer to the diagram below and the quilt photo for colour positioning.

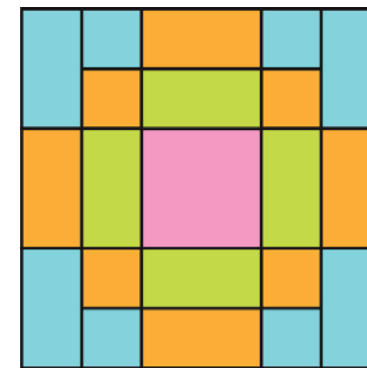
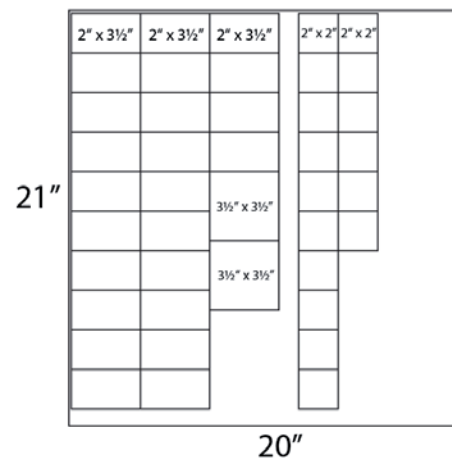


SETTING THE BLOCKS

- The quilt is made up of 8 rows, with 6 blocks in each row.
- Use the image on the cover to help you plan your quilt layout. This is best done by laying out the completed blocks and moving them around to achieve a good balance of colour.
- Starting in the top left hand corner sew the blocks together. Repeat for the remaining 7 rows.
- Press these rows in alternate directions, this will ensure the seams nest nicely together when sewing the rows together.
- Sew the 8 rows together.

Quilt top is now complete.
